If you have some junior wildlife lovers looking for fun over the holidays, check out Moonlit Sanctuary's Keeper Club holiday program.

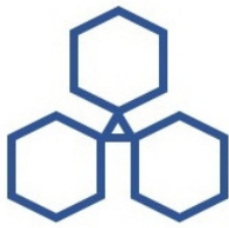
In a day full of fun hands-on activities, kids get up close to many animals including kangaroos and pythons and learn how their keepers work to keep them happy and healthy.

The clinic combines fun adventure activities such as flying fox or giant swing with skills-based football sessions followed by a structured and supervised match play to ensure maximum fun and footy development!

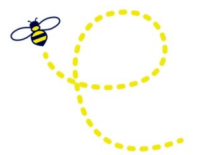
**Professional Coaching**
