2024 Foundation Transition

2024 School Finishing Time

The Victorian Government Schools Agreement 2022 requires all staff to have a 30 minute break from duties between 11:30am-2:30pm each day. Under the 2023 daily structure, EPS staff only have 25 minutes. To enable this to occur school council approved the adjustment of the school's timeframe to have instruction commencing at 9.00am and finishing at 3:20pm, instead of 3:15pm.


We will continue to work through plans and concepts which will then be analysed for costing and operational aspects.
